


Welcome

We would like to take this opportunity to thank you for choosing York Swimming Academy. This letter contains useful information to help you make the most of our service. Using Our Facilities (Stamford Bridge, York)

Please use postcode YO41 1BP. If the school gates are locked, you will need to follow Moor road round to the right behind the church and park on Lob Lane or Saxon Road.





When I arrive at the pool, what do I do?

A member of the team will greet you by the fire door and direct you to your seats. To minimise crowding in the corridors and on poolside we ask that you **arrive no more than 5 minutes** before the scheduled start time of your child's lesson.

We have limited changing capacity available so to help us manage our changing rooms **please ensure your child arrives at the pool 'swim ready'** with swimming costumes on underneath easy to remove clothes, such as a onsie or tracksuit, that can be taken off on poolside prior to lessons starting. If your child requires assistance in the changing room, male guardians should take the child into the male changing rooms and female guardians should use the female changing rooms. Once your child is changed, they should walk through to reach the poolside where they will be met by the teaching team. At this point duty of care is handed over to their teacher.

As spectating is limited, we kindly request that only one parent or guardian accompanies each swimmer to their lesson.

Changing Rooms

In the interests of safeguarding, please ensure adults are not entering the opposite gender changing rooms under any circumstances. Children over the age of 8 must get changed in their respective gender changing room. Once your child is changed, they should walk through the blue door to reach the poolside where they will be met by the teaching team. At this point duty of care is handed over to their teacher.
